Acra, NY— The Spring 2017 WGXC Record and Media Fair will take place on Sunday, April 30, 2017 from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the Basilica Back Gallery, 110 S. Front St., Hudson, NY 12534. This spring, the Fair is presented in conjunction with Basilica Hudson's annual 24-HOUR DRONE: EXPERIMENTS IN SOUND AND MUSIC, which gathers hundreds of serious music fans for a 24-hour festival. The WGXC Record Fair winds up, as 24-DRONE winds down. Food and beverage will be available on the Basilica grounds throughout the day.
