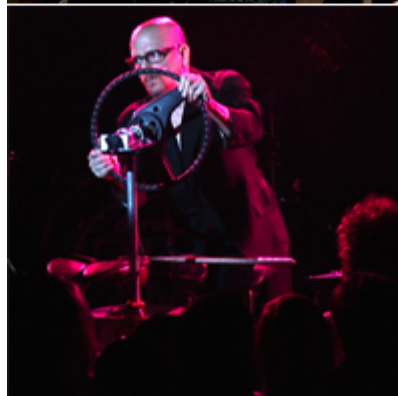
Radio Wonderland Record Release with Tom Roe and Echo Roe, Crazyed, Fulathela

SEiZE the MEANS, the debut album from Radio Wonderland, a weekly live broadcast every Saturday at 10:30 a.m. on Wave Farm's WGXC 90.7-FM. Radio Wonderland is Joshua Fried remixing live FM radio. The evening begins with Tom Roe and daughter Echo Roe, in a reprisal of their recent performance at the international radio art festival, Radio Revolten in Halle, Germany. Crazyed is the improvised musical project of Hudson's Max Hamel and Jack Schoonover. Their live sets and recorded output utilize unconventional patching and programming to unearth new electronic sounds and rhythms. Late night hours will feature sounds from Hudson-based DJ Fulathela. The event will be broadcast live on WGXC 90.7-FM and Wave Farm Radio.
