From 2012 - 2021, **Remote Audio Outpost** was a solar-powered recording booth installed in one of the most remote corners of the Wave Farm property and outfitted with a rotary phone for both recording and transmission. Today, **Remote Audio Outpost** serves as a listening space, amplifying recordings made during the project's first decade as well as new messages left at the **Boomerang** phone booth.

Installed at the entrance/exit of the Study Center, the **Boomerang** booth records personal ephemera, confessions, and salutations from visitors as they depart Wave Farm. Messages left at **Boomerang** are shared with future Wave Farm visitors at the **Remote Audio Outpost**.
